ISAT Data Presentation – Breaking the Pattern

Based on the 2009 ISAT data, as well as trend data, changes are being made to our intervention programs. Across the grade levels, approximately 90% of the students are meeting or exceeding expectations in the area of reading. Students not meeting expectations receive extra support from reading specialists and extended-day, Assets teachers. Some of these students also receive support from ELL teachers and special education teachers. Teams of teachers have been collaborating to ensure that the instruction our students receive is coordinated and consistent throughout the day. The percentage of students meeting or exceeding expectations in the area of mathematics ranges from 95 – 98%. More students are receiving accelerated instruction this year than have received accelerated instruction in the past. Students qualify for the Grades 4 – 8 Math Honors classes based on a set of student achievement data.

Our student learning goals for 2011 are as follows:

98% of students will meet/exceed expectations in the areas of reading and math

40% of students will exceed expectations in the area of reading

70% of students will exceed expectations in the area of math
