Literary terms:

- *Conflict: the struggle between a character and an opposing force.
- *Plot: the sequence of events in the story.
- *Antonym—words that are opposite.
- *Fiction: A work of the imagination.
- *Setting: The place and time period in which a story takes place.
- *Nonfiction: Work based of fact.
- *Context Clues: Information in text that surrounds a word and determines its meaning.
- *Synonym: Words are the same or similar in meaning.
- *Characterization: A description of individuals in a story.
- *Prediction: A statement about the future.
- *Inference: Using facts from the text and personal experience to draw a logical conclusion.
