## *PreKindergarten and CEDA - Head Start*

**Children must be born between 9/2/04 and 9/1/06 to be eligible for  
Preschool at Quin for the 2009 – 2010 school year.**

**Documentation required:** If you want your child to participate in preschool at Quin, you must come to Quin Early Learning Center to register. The Quin office is open 9:00AM – 3:00PM. You must bring your child's birth certificate, social security card, and three proofs of residency as indicated on the back (you must be a resident of North Palos School District 117). Head Start applicants must also submit proof of income.

**Screenings:** All students will be screened in the following areas: vocabulary, visual-motor integration, language and speech development, English proficiency, fine and gross motor skills, social skills and cognitive development. Mandatory screenings will be held May 22 and June 2 for PreKindergarten. Head Start screenings will be held May 18 – May 21. You will be given a screening appointment after you have submitted the blue enrollment folder in addition to the required documentation. Children turning three years old during the summer are not eligible for this screening, but parents are encouraged to register now so we may contact you for the August screening.

#### PreKindergarten at Quin:

- Free program to District 117 residents
- Students attend five days per week (Monday-Friday)
- Morning session for Palos Hills residents (8:45AM -11:20AM)
- Afternoon session for Hickory Hills and Bridgeview residents (12:30PM – 3:15PM)
- Free bus service is offered
- Parent Participation is mandatory - a parent must participate a minimum of one time per month (workshops, classroom activities, field trips, etc.)
- All students are required to submit a current physical by the first day of school in August.

#### Head Start at Quin:

- Free program to low-income District 117 residents
- Students attend five days per week (Monday-Friday), 8:45AM – 2:00PM
- Free bus service is offered
- Parent Participation is strongly encouraged
- Home Visits and Parent Conferences are mandatory
- All students are required to submit a current physical and dental by the first day of school in August.

**Register Now – Enrollment is Limited!**

**Registration documents required:**

- Child's birth certificate
  - If foreign born, passport is also required
- Child's social security card

**Three proofs of residency are required.**

A minimum of one of the following must be submitted:

- Mortgage papers identifying name of child's parent/guardian
- Real estate tax bill identifying name of child's parent/guardian
- Property title identifying name of child's parent/guardian
- Copy of lease signed by landlord identifying name of child's parent/guardian.

In addition to one of the above, **two** of the following must also be submitted:

- Current Utility Bills (internet bills not accepted)
- Car Insurance

**REGULAR U.S. MAIL IS NOT ACCEPTABLE**  
**DRIVER'S LICENSE IS NOT ACCEPTABLE**

- ***PreKindergarten applicants do not need to provide proof of income***
- ***Applicants for the low-income Head Start program must submit proof of income***
