

## Immunization and Health Requirements for District #117

Attention all Parents and Guardians,

Please review this list below with your child’s physician to make sure all of these requirements are met. These requirements are mandated for all students by both the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Illinois State Board of Education. ***These items must be completed and turned into the school by October 15 of the school year or sooner to avoid possible exclusion.***

*If you have any questions, please contact the health clerk or nurse of your respective school.*

<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Physical Exam</b> –this includes the physician completing the Diabetes Screening, Lead Risk Questionnaire (Pre-K, K), Mental Health, Emergency Action Plans, and participation of PE/sports.	<b>A new health exam is required for any child entering:</b> Early Childhood, Pre-K, Kindergarten (or First grade if not previously enrolled in K), sixth grade, and any child entering an IL school from out of state or out of country. <b><i>The exam must be completed no earlier than 365 days prior to start of school. Only Child Health Exam forms dated 11/2015 may be used.</i></b>
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Parent Section</b>	<b>Parents must complete the yes/no questions (including allergies/medications) listed under Health History, provide signature and date.</b>
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>TB Skin or Blood Test</b>	Recommended for children in high risk groups, those that travel to/from high prevalence countries, or those exposed to adults in high risk categories as per physician order.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>DTP/DTaP, Td</b>	<b>Early Childhood, Pre-K</b> – 3 doses <b>First Entry into school (K or 1<sup>st</sup>)</b> – 4 doses (last on/after 4 <sup>th</sup> bday). <b>Other grades</b> – 3 or more doses DTP/DTaP or Td (last on/after 4 <sup>th</sup> bday).
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Tdap</b>	One dose for any child in 6 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup> grade.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Polio (must all be either IPV or OPV)</b>	<b>Early Childhood, Pre-K</b> – 3 doses <b>First Entry into school (K or 1<sup>st</sup>)</b> – 4 doses (last on/after 4 <sup>th</sup> bday). <b>Other grades</b> – 3 or more doses DTP/DTaP or Td (last on/after 4 <sup>th</sup> bday).
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Hepatitis B</b>	<b>Early Childhood, Pre-K</b> – 3 doses (last dose on/after 6 months age) <b>Grades 6-8:</b> 3 doses of Hep. B or 2 doses Adult Recombivax HB for ages 11 to 15 years.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>MMR</b>	<b>Early Childhood, Pre-K</b> – one dose on/after 1 <sup>st</sup> bday. <b>Kindergarten</b> – 8 <sup>th</sup> – two doses required
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Varicella</b>	<b>Early Childhood, Pre-K</b> – one dose on/after 1 <sup>st</sup> bday. <b>Kindergarten</b> – 8 <sup>th</sup> – two doses required
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Meningococcal</b>	One dose for any child in 6 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup> grade (on/after 11 <sup>th</sup> bday)
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Dental Exam</b>	<b>Students entering kindergarten, grade 2, and grade 6</b> are required to have an oral health examination. Each child is required to present proof of examination by a dentist prior to May 15 of the school year. School dental examinations must have been completed within the 18 months prior to the May 15 deadline.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Eye Exam</b>	<b>Any child entering the Illinois school system at the kindergarten level or higher for the first time is required to have an eye examination regardless of grade level.</b> The deadline for submitting this form is by October 15 of the school year.
