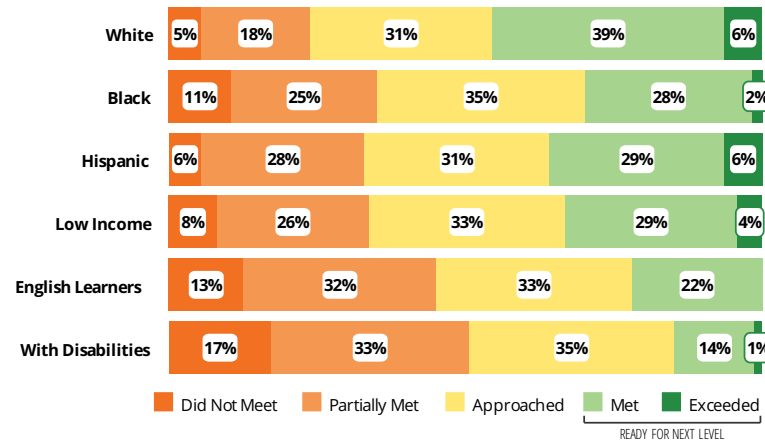
Academic Success

This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.

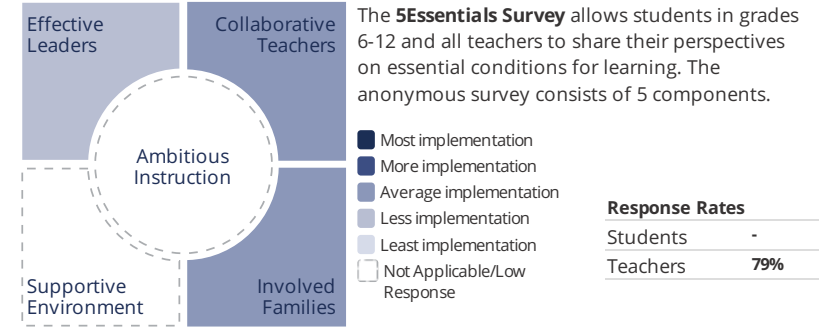

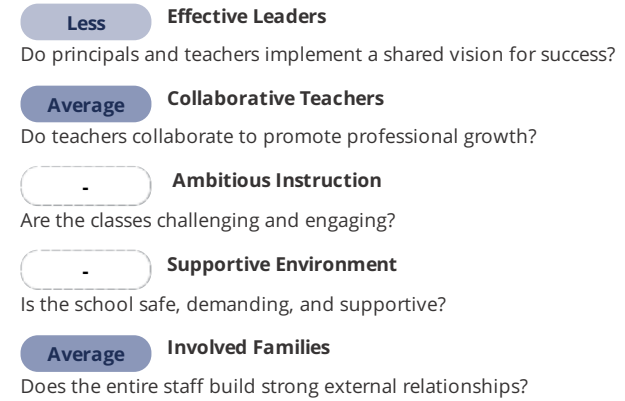
School Environment

Response Rates

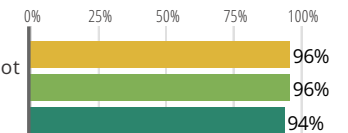

Student Attendance and Mobility

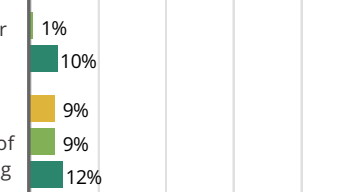
Attendance Rate

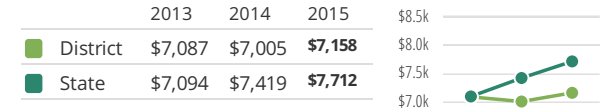

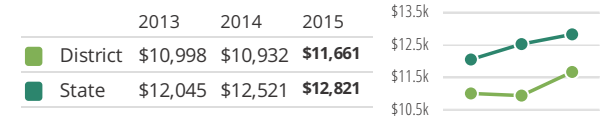
