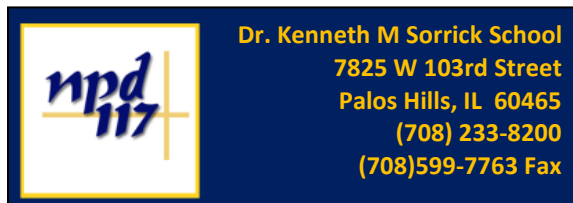

FIRST GRADE

1	14x16 or larger backpack without wheels (must fit a 2- pocket folder)
2	8" x 5" (or smaller) plastic school boxes without handles
12	glue sticks
24	#2 Ticonderoga pencils (sharpened)
4	pink erasers
4	boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
1	box of 8, wide washable Crayola markers
1	box of 8, thin washable Crayola markers
2	pairs of pointed Fiskars scissors
5	folders with bottom pockets only (no center-hole fasteners) 1 each: red, blue, green yellow, purple
1	3-pack of highlighters
1	wide-ruled notebook
2	4-packs of thick black EXPO dry-erase markers
1	computer headset (no ear buds)
2	large boxes of Kleenex
1	roll of paper towels
3	containers of anti-bacterial wipes (No Clorox brand)
2	boxes of gallon-size Ziplock bags
1	box of sandwich-size Ziplock bags (boys)
1	box of snack-size Ziplock bags (girls)
1	pair of gym shoes for gross motor activities. For safety reasons, students should not wear slip-ons, fashion heels, sling backs, or clog-style shoes.
