PRE-KINDERGARTEN

1 14x16 or larger backpack (must fit a 2-pocket folder) **without** wheels
1 change of clothes

KINDERGARTEN

1 14x16 or larger backpack (must fit a 2-pocket folder) **without** wheels
15 white or clear glue sticks
2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (no “fat” sized crayons in large boxes/packages or fluorescent colors)
12 Ticonderoga sharpened #2 plain, yellow pencils
1 pair “Fiskar for kids” pointed scissors
2 folders with bottom pockets only (1 red and 1 blue)
1 4-pack thick colored Expo dry erase Markers
1-4 pack Playdoh brand dough
1 large box of Kleenex
1 container anti-bacterial wipes (**No Clorox brand**)
1 roll paper towels
1 8 x 5 (or smaller) plastic school box without handles
1 computer headset (no ear buds)
1 clean, unused white children’s sock (for use to erase white boards)
Boys: 1 box of sandwich-size Ziplock bags
Girls: 1 box of gallon-size Ziplock bags

One pair of gym shoes for gross motor activities. For safety reasons, students should not wear slip-ons, fashion heels, sling backs, or clog- style shoes.

Kindergarten students receiving bilingual services will need to double the supplies listed above.

FIRST GRADE

1 14x16 or larger backpack (must fit a 2-pocket folder) **without** wheels
1 ruler
24 glue sticks
1 small bottle of Elmer’s school glue
2 pink erasers
48 Ticonderoga brand sharpened #2 plain, yellow pencils
2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
1 box of 8 wide, washable Crayola markers
5 folders with bottom pockets only (no center-hole fasteners)
1 pair of pointed Fiskar scissors
1 large box of Kleenex
1 8 x 5 (or smaller) plastic school box without handles
1 3-pack of highlighters
2 pencil sharpeners
1 4-pack of black EXPO dry erase markers
1 box of gallon-size Ziplock bags
1 box of sandwich-size Ziplock bags
1 roll of paper towels
2 containers of wet wipes or anti-bacterial wet ones (**No Clorox brand**)
1 pair of head phones (**no ear buds**)
