TOUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. **NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES OR DELAYS.** Pathway Tours Inc. (Pathway Tours) does not own or operate any transportation utilized, hotels or sites visited on the Tour. Pathway Tours shall not be liable for any delay, loss or accident occasioned by fault or negligence of any carrier or person or company obligated to perform transportation services, furnish accommodations, or otherwise in connection with the Tour. Pathway Tours shall not be responsible for specifically but not limited to the following: any loss, expense or inconvenience caused by late arrivals and departures of ships, airplanes, busses, trains, autos or any change of schedule, acts or inaction of carriers, hotels, other third parties or other events or occurrences beyond the reasonable control of Pathway Tours. Pathway Tours shall not be liable for loss or damage to baggage or any other personal property of the Participant. Pathway Tours and the transportation company shall have no liability to Participants who are late for departure or miss scheduled departures. In the event the Tour Group of which Participant is a member shall breach the Tour Contract, all payments made by Participant shall be retained by Pathway Tours to be applied to damages incurred by Pathway Tours. Additionally, such retention of payment shall not prevent Pathway Tours from seeking recovery of additional damages from the Tour Group caused to it by such breach.
2. **RATE CHANGES, CHANGES TO ITINERARY.** Rates quoted are based on current taxes, tariffs and fuel costs in effect at the present time and are subject to change without notice. In the event of a tax increase or fuel surcharge, participant agrees to pay the additional cost. If participant chooses to cancel due to the increase in cost, all cancellation penalties will apply. Although no revisions to the itinerary are anticipated, Pathway Tours reserves the right to make any changes, without notice, that may become necessary. Participant agrees to pay any additional expenses or costs attributed to such changes in the Itinerary.
3. **RULES FOR TOUR PARTICIPANTS.** Tour leaders, chaperones or school administration have the right to remove a tour participant anytime prior to the tour if the tour participant does not meet school's or group's eligibility or code of conduct requirements and all cancellation penalties will apply. Authorization is hereby given to the tour leaders and chaperones to act on behalf of any participant who shall require hospital, surgical or medical treatment in any situation deemed an emergency by the chaperone. Any medications or medicines a Participant will be taking on Tour, must be submitted to the chaperones prior to the commencement of the Tour. The tour leaders and chaperones are to be notified by the Participant of any known allergies to medication. Participant agrees to fully comply with all rules and regulations of various governmental and commercial agencies and that any violation of such rules and regulations, as well as any behavior deemed by the tour leaders or chaperones to be detrimental to the Tour Group, will, at the sole discretion of the tour leaders and chaperones, subject the Participant to immediate suspension and/or dismissal from the Tour. No refunds shall be made in any such event and the Participant, or the parent/guardian of the Participant, will be financially responsible for any costs to return the participant and a chaperone home. immediate dismissal from the Tour. Participant agrees to be responsible for all damages caused by the Participant to the hotel, motor coach or any other property. Pathway Tours is not responsible or liable for any items lost or stolen while on tour.
4. **DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS.** All payments must be received by Pathway Tours according to the payment schedule. All tours must be paid in full by the deadline listed on this agreement to avoid cancellation and applicable penalties. A payment made after the final payment date must be in the form of credit card, cashier's check, money order or cash. No personal checks will be accepted after the final payment date. Any payments made by credit card will incur a 3.0% transaction fee. NSF checks and Credit Card Chargebacks will be charged a \$30.00 fee.
5. **REFUND POLICY.** All cancellations must be submitted to Pathway Tours in writing before any refund will be considered. Any applicable refunds will be made to the issuer(s) no later than 30 days after the scheduled Tour Date. Cancellations within 45 days of any tour will incur a 100% penalty and receive no refund.
In the event of a Tour Group cancellation, the following applies:
 - a. If Tour Group cancels due to lack of participation, the group has 2 weeks after the first scheduled deposit date to cancel without penalty.
 - b. If Tour Group cancels more than 2 weeks after the deposit due date, the Tour Group shall receive a refund equal to payments made, less any non-refundable deposits, expenses made on behalf of the group and an administrative charge of \$25.00 per person.In the event of a Participant cancellation, the following applies:
 - a. If a Participant cancels at least 46 days prior to the Tour date, he or she shall receive a refund equal to payments made, less any non-refundable deposits, expenses made on behalf of the participants and an administrative charge of \$25.00.
 - b. If a Participant cancels 45 days or less prior to the Tour date, he or she shall incur a 100% penalty and receive no refund.
6. **TOUR COSTS.** Tour pricing is based on a certain number of participants per motor coach as stated in the first page of the Tour Agreement. Any late cancellations or additions will not affect the final established price at the final payment date. Any new tour participants that sign up for the tour after the final payment deadline will be charged a \$25.00 fee, plus the additional cost of

airfare, if applicable. The costs stated herein are for student participants only. Costs for adult participants will be greater and will be quoted upon request.

7. INSURANCE COVERAGE. Optional Tour cancellation is available to the Participant for an additional charge. If a medical emergency prevents the participant and chaperone from traveling back with the group, it will be up the parent/guardian to pay any additional expense for the student and chaperone to return home.
8. PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL RELEASE. The undersigned hereby irrevocably consents to the unrestricted use by Pathway Tours, its successor and assigns, of any and all photographs or video footage of Participant taken on the tour for all advertising purposes, promotional purposes or purposes of trade in any and all mediums, and the undersigned waives any right to compensation and any right to inspect or approve such pictures, video footage, advertising, or material used therewith.
9. ACCPETANCE, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION. In consideration of Pathway Tours acceptance of the below-named participant for the tour, the undersigned hereby agrees to indemnify, Pathway Tours Inc, the tour sponsor and the tour leader participating in the tour, their successors and assigns and their shareholders, directors, officers, employees and agents, as applicable, from any and all manner of action, suit, debts, damages whatsoever, in law, in admiralty or in equity, which said participant may have or may hereafter acquire by reason of death or injury as a participant of said tour, loss or damage to property, or otherwise arising out of or in connection with participant in said tour, including, but not limited to, any and all damages claimed for delays and other causes beyond Pathway Tours reasonable control. The participant's deposit shall constitute acceptance of the participant for participation in the tour.
10. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Illinois. The parties agree that any claims or other actions arising out of this agreement shall be litigated in the Federal or State courts in DuPage County, Illinois.
