

GLEN OAKS SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

We strive to provide the best educational environment possible for all students at Glen Oaks School. Appropriate behavior is always expected. You will find specific expectations for student behavior below. Please refer to the student handbook section of the district calendar for more detailed policies. We have discussed appropriate behavior in an assembly with students and ask that you take the time to review the expectations listed on this page with your Glen Oaks student.

The teacher and/or administrator will determine consequences for the violation of rules.

GENERAL BEHAVIOR

Each student will:

1. BEHAVE IN A MANNER THAT IS NOT DISRUPTIVE TO THE EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT.
2. Display appropriate behavior at all times.
3. Show respect to peers, self, and adults by not using profane or inappropriate language, gestures, or behaviors.
4. Respond to teachers and adults appropriately and respectfully.
5. Not participate in bullying activities on school grounds or to and from school. Any form of bullying will not be tolerated.
6. Follow directions the first time they are given.
7. Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself. This includes, for example: fighting, "play fighting," hitting, tripping, kicking, and writing on others.
8. No touch or take other people's belongings: i.e., papers, pencils, lunches.
9. Not chew gum on school property.
10. Not bring dangerous or illegal items to school. (Sprays of any kind, nail files, sharp implements, etc. are included in this rule.)
11. Walk silently through all hallways.
12. Not be allowed to use the school phone or a cell phone without permission and then only for emergencies. (Lunch, homework, or musical instruments forgotten at home are not emergencies.)
13. Not bring cell phones, electronic games, radios, mp3 players, sports equipment, trading cards, toys, or anything used as a toy to school. These items may be confiscated by teachers and turned in to the office. School personnel are not responsible for missing or broken items.
14. Not possess or use laser pointers in school.
15. Not bring skateboards, roller blades, or scooters to school.
16. Not write on desks, walls, bathroom stalls, or in any way deface school property. Student/parent will be required to replace or pay for the repair of any vandalized school property.
17. Be prepared for classes by having the appropriate books and materials.
18. Not participate in cheating either by giving or taking the answers from another student or copying the work of other students.
19. Not participate in after school activities if they have not been in attendance on the day of the activity. This includes, for example, after school gym, clubs, and PTA-sponsored after school events.
20. Leave nonessential personal grooming items (i.e. nail polish, hair spray, lotion, makeup, etc.) at home.

MORNING ENTRY

1. Students are not allowed to enter the building before 8:15 a.m.
2. Students must enter quietly and calmly while following adult supervisors' directions.
3. Students are to proceed directly to their classrooms and wait quietly and calmly in a line in the hall if the teacher is not present.
4. No open food, gum, or beverages may be brought in to the building.

DRESS CODE

The following guidelines should be followed and will be determined by the teacher and administrator.

1. Dress and grooming should be in a manner which is conducive to a good learning environment and appropriate for the age level of the child. Due to health concerns, make-up should be left at home.
2. Spandex/stretch pants will not be allowed unless worn with a skirt, shorts, or long top.
3. Shorts and skirts must be an appropriate length when standing and sitting.
4. Pants which are worn low on the hips are not permitted. Oversized pants may be worn with a belt buckled at the waist. Pant legs must both be worn at the ankle without rubber bands.
5. Mesh and sheer fabrics, bare midriffs, and clothing, including backpacks, with inappropriate language and/or symbols are not allowed. This includes inappropriate video games, movies, beverages, and movies/television shows. Consideration will be given to socially acceptable rating systems when determining appropriateness.
6. Inappropriate tank tops are not allowed. All shirts should have shoulder coverage – halter tops, off the shoulder, and one shoulder shirts are not appropriate.
7. Tops with large cutout armholes are not allowed.
8. Hats and coats are not to be worn in the classroom. Hats are to be worn in an appropriate manner on school grounds and removed when in the building.
9. Sturdy shoes should be worn at all times to prevent injury during daily physical development and P.E. classes. Sandals without back straps, flip-flops, clogs, and shoes with wheels are not appropriate.

BUS CONDUCT

The bus is an extension of the classroom and all general rules apply.

Students are expected to always do the following:

1. refrain from loud and/or excessive talking, screaming, and/or shouting.
2. remain in the seats while the bus is in motion.
3. enter and exit the bus in an orderly fashion.
4. refrain from the use of profanity or insulting remarks.
5. never eat or drink on the bus.

POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES

Failure to follow conduct guidelines as outlined above or as outlined in the student handbook portion of the district calendar will result in one or more of the following consequences:

1. Verbal redirection
2. Phone call to parent
3. Student generated letter of apology or verbal apology
4. Visit to principal
5. Loss of privileges
6. Reparation for damages
7. Suspension or exclusion from bus for bus conduct violations
8. Lunch/physical development detention
9. After school detention (It will be parent's responsibility to pick up student from school.)
10. In-school suspension
11. Out of school suspension
12. Expulsion/alternative school placement

Review these rules with your child and save them for your referral. Your child will also review them with his/her classroom teacher. Return the bottom portion to school.
